



Annual Walton County Masonic Chili Cookoff

Community Division Guidelines

Contestants are encouraged to pre-register; Same day registration will be accepted the day of the cookoff. Pre-registration deadline is February 08, 2025.

Chili must be prepared in advance and brought in slow cookers or have a way to keep warm.

Walnut Grove Lodge will provide extension cords and power strips for slow cookers. Chili must be warm upon arrival.

All ingredients are OK to use, no restrictions. You may make any style of chili you wish. If you are using ingredients people may be allergic to, please make signs to be posted at your station. Please also post the spiciness level of your chili so that you can inform the tasters.

Feel free to bring all your own condiments. If you are including cornbread or any other condiments, please make sure they can be shared in small serving sizes prior to distribution.

Sample cups and spoons will be provided.

If any chili remains once the cookoff ends, contestants are responsible for taking it home or disposing of it.

General Judging

Every cookoff contestant will be assigned a number and a cup with a coordinating number. A panel of judges will taste each chili and give it a score.

The winner will receive a Chili Cookoff 1st place Ribbon and bragging rights for the next year! Ribbons will also be awarded for 2nd and 3rd place.

Winners will be announced at 3:00 pm.
